The Annual Forum is organised by Association of Young Legal Historians and Faculty of Law and Administration, University of Warsaw.

The Polish capital hosted young legal historians during Xth Annual Forum of Young Legal Historians under the title “The European Legal Community: Between Tradition and Perspectives” in 2004 at the same time of Poland’s accession to the European Union.

#### **Venue**

The Annual Forum will be held between Thursday, 14 June, and Sunday, 17 June 2018. All sessions will take place in the Annual Forum Centre at the Collegium Iuridicum II of the Faculty of Law and Administration of the University of Warsaw located next to the University of Warsaw Library at 4 Lipowa Street. Collegium Iuridicum II is found nearby the main University Campus and it can be accessed easily by bus or metro (Centrum Nauki Kopernik station). The venue boasts modern auditoria and conference rooms fully equipped with audio-visual facilities. At the disposal of the Annual Forum participants will be 4 conference rooms seating 140 persons, as well as a spacious auditorium for up to 200 persons.

Opening session will take place in the Tyszkiewicz-Potocki Palace next to the gate to the main University Campus at 32, Krakowskie Przedmieście Street. The opening session will be followed by the Welcome Cocktail held in Kazimierzowski Palace located also at the main University Campus.

#### **Accommodation**

The Annual Forum venue is located in the neighbourhood of several hotels representing a selection of standards. The accommodation offer with special rates for Annual Forum participants will be posted on the website and included in the second circular.

### **Sessions**

Three days of sessions will be scheduled. The fourth day will be reserved for the tour exploring number of Warsaw historical sites.

The papers will be presented in English.

The parallel sessions will group papers according to subject matter. Participant's presentation should not exceed 20 minutes.

The Participants will be required to submit abstracts (max. 200 words) of papers with a synthetic CV and list of publications by e-mail to: [forum2018aylh@gmail.com](mailto:forum2018aylh@gmail.com), or through the registration form found in the website: <http://forum2018aylh.uw.edu.pl>. The call for papers containing relevant details will be distributed till the end of November 2017.
